



# Privacy Policy

May 25, 2018

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which comes into force on May 25th, 2018, aims to protect the fundamental right to privacy and the protection of personal data of European Union (EU) citizens. This regulation affects any entity (including websites) that processes EU citizens' personal data. This is regardless if we live in the EU.

As part of the new regulation, we must let our customers know how we collect, store, and use their data, in a clear and transparent way.

## **Raedene's Dancin' Stars Studio Data Collection Policy –**

We do not sell or use customer information for any reason but to conduct business. We ask customers to enter credit card information from their own computer systems, or we swipe the card to enter the number. On a rare occurrence, if a customer shares a credit card number over the phone, we immediately enter the data into the Jackrabbit Class software and then dispose of the number.

**The following is information that has been presented from our host server – Wix.com.**

### ***What type of information do you collect?***

*We receive, collect and store any information you enter on our website or provide us in any other way. In addition, we collect the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet; login; e-mail address; password; computer and connection information and purchase history. We may use software tools to measure and collect session information, including page response times, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information, and methods used to browse away from the page. We also collect personally identifiable information (including name, email, password, communications); payment details (including credit card information), comments, feedback, product reviews, recommendations, and personal profile.*

### ***How do you collect information?***

*When you conduct a transaction on our website, as part of the process, we collect personal information you give us such as your name, address and email address. Your personal information will be used for the specific reasons stated above only.*

### ***Why do you collect such personal information?***

*We collect such Non-personal and Personal Information for the following purposes:*

- 1. To provide and operate the Services;*
- 2. To provide our Users with ongoing customer assistance and technical support;*
- 3. To be able to contact our Visitors and Users with general or personalized service-related notices and promotional messages;*
- 4. To create aggregated statistical data and other aggregated and/or inferred Non-personal Information, which we or our business partners may use to provide and improve our respective services;*
- 5. To comply with any applicable laws and regulations.*

### ***How do you store, use, share and disclose your site visitors' personal information?***

*Our company is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.*

*All direct payment gateways offered by Wix.com and used by our company adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of credit card information by our store and its service providers.*

### **How do you communicate with your site visitors?**

We may contact you to notify you regarding your account, to troubleshoot problems with your account, to resolve a dispute, to collect fees or monies owed, to poll your opinions through surveys or questionnaires, to send updates about our company, or as otherwise necessary to contact you to enforce our User Agreement, applicable national laws, and any agreement we may have with you. For these purposes we may contact you via email, telephone, text messages, and postal mail.

### **How do you use cookies and other tracking tools?**

Cookies are small pieces of data stored on a site visitor's browser, usually used to keep track of their movements and actions on a site. Cookies are implemented in every site built by Wix. Take a look at the table below to view which cookies Wix implements on Wix sites:

## **Privacy Policy**

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the <https://www.jackrabbitclass.com> and Jackrabbit Technologies, Inc. and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Jackrabbit Technologies, Inc. include <https://www.jackrabbitclass.com> and Jackrabbit. The Jackrabbit website is a Class Management Software site. By using the Jackrabbit website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

## **Collection of your Personal Information**

Jackrabbit may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future. As used in this Privacy Policy, “personal information” shall be defined as it is in the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Jackrabbit. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Jackrabbit website.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Jackrabbit’s public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

Jackrabbit encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Jackrabbit so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Jackrabbit is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Jackrabbit website.

## **Use of your Personal Information**

Jackrabbit collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Jackrabbit may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Jackrabbit and its affiliates.

Jackrabbit may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Jackrabbit does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Jackrabbit may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited

from using your personal information except to provide these services to Jackrabbit, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Jackrabbit may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Jackrabbit, in order to determine what Jackrabbit services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Jackrabbit to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Jackrabbit will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Jackrabbit or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Jackrabbit; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Jackrabbit, or the public.

## **Use of Cookies**

The Jackrabbit website may use “cookies” to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Jackrabbit pages, or register with Jackrabbit site or services, a cookie helps Jackrabbit to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Jackrabbit website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Jackrabbit features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Jackrabbit services or websites you visit.

## **Legal Basis for Collecting Your Personal Information**

Whenever we collect personal information from you, we may do so on the following legal bases:

1. Your consent to such collection and use;
2. Out of necessity for the performance of an agreement between us and you, such as your agreement to use our solutions;
3. Our legitimate business interest, including but not limited to the following circumstances where collecting or using personal information is necessary for:
  - Intra-organization transfers for client data for administrative purposes;
  - Product development and enhancement, where the processing enables us to enhance, modify, personalize, or otherwise improve our services and communications for the benefit of our users, and to better understand how people interact with our Website;
  - Communications and marketing, including processing data for direct marketing purposes, and subject to your opt-in for these purposes, and to determine the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and advertising;

- Fraud detection and prevention;
- Enhancement of our cybersecurity, including improving the security of our network and information systems; and
- General business operations and diligence.

In each circumstance, however, we will weigh the necessity of our processing for the purpose against your privacy and confidentiality interests, including taking into account your reasonable expectations, the impact of processing, and any safeguards which are or could be put in place. In all circumstances, we will limit such processing for our legitimate business interest to what is necessary for its purposes.

## **Our Retention of your Personal Information**

We may retain your personal information for a period of time consistent with the original purpose for collection. For example, we keep your personal information for no longer than reasonably necessary for your use of our products and services and for a reasonable period of time afterward. We also may retain your personal information during the period of time needed for us to pursue our legitimate business interests, conduct audits, comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

## **European Users' Rights With Regard to Personal Information**

Some data protection laws, including GDPR, provide you with certain rights in connection with personal information you have shared with us. If you are resident in the European Economic Area, you may have the following rights:

1. The right to be informed. You are entitled to be informed of the use of your personal information. This Privacy Policy provides such information to you.
2. The right of access. You have the right to request a copy of your personal information which we hold about you.
3. The right of correction: You have the right to request correction or changes of your personal information if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date.
4. The right to be forgotten: You have the right to request us, at any time, to delete your personal information from our servers and to erase your personal information when it is no longer necessary for us to retain such data. Note, however, that deletion of your personal information will likely impact your ability to use our services.
5. The right to object (opt-out): You have the right to opt-out of certain uses of your personal information, such as direct marketing, at any time.
6. The right to data portability: You have the right to a "portable" copy of your personal information that you have submitted to us. Generally, this means your right to request that we move, copy or transmit your personal information stored on our servers / IT environment to another service provider's servers / IT environment.
7. The right to refuse to be subjected to automated decision making, including profiling: You have the right not to be subject to a decision and insist on human intervention if the decision is based on automated processing and produces a legal effect or a similarly significant effect on you.
8. The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.


## Data Encryption

Jackrabbit is committed to data security with respect to information collected and maintained on our site(s). To help protect confidential information, we support the ability to encrypt all data. Encryption is the process where software is used to scramble confidential information in transit to and from Jackrabbit.

Through Jackrabbit, you are asking your customers for sensitive information such as usernames, passwords, credit card numbers, etc. Our SSL Certificate (GoDaddy) uses advanced encryption to prevent potential hackers from accessing this data.

Jackrabbit utilizes a TLS 1.2 security protocol and meets the latest PCI compliance standards effective June 30, 2018. This protocol is an industry standard designed to protect the privacy of information communicated over the Internet.

## Privacy at Square

Square respects your privacy and works hard to protect your personal information. We want you to understand how we may collect, store, use and protect your personal information. We will not share your information with anyone except as described in this [Privacy Policy](#). When you downloaded our software in order to use our services you agreed to accept this policy. We may change this policy at any time. We will post notifications of revised versions of our policy on our website, and revised policies will be immediately effective. Throughout this Privacy Policy, we will refer to our website, software, and services collectively as the “Service.” Please note, this Privacy Policy does not apply to information we collect by other means than your use of the Service (including offline) or from other sources.
